Brazil does not have specific ERW-victim assistance policies, as there are no mine fields in the country.

This notwithstanding, free and universal health care, including mental health, is available to all Brazilians and Brazilian residents, including those who have been or may be affected by conflict elsewhere. Likewise, access to welfare programmes, such as social protection services and cash-based transfer policies are available to all socially vulnerable Brazilian and Brazilian residents, including refugees, without discrimination.

We fully support the call to embed and integrate victim assistance measures into wider public policies, without losing sight of the specific needs of land-mine survivors and their communities. In this regard, we highlight Actions 33, 34, 38 and 39 as particularly relevant.
